- 2.** Print, fill out, and sign SCI-FI's Consent Form from our website.
- 3.** Have your child write a short letter to SCI-FI Science Camps c/o Rena Bartsch that explains why they would like to attend camp this summer. The letter does not have to mention the bursary.
- 4.** Mail or fax your completed **bursary application, child's letter, and signed camp consent form** to SCI-FI Science Camps by June 17th, 2011 at noon for Saskatoon camps. **Due to a limited amount of bursary funding, late applications cannot be processed.**

A bursary will cover the cost of one week of camp; it will not cover options like Extended Hours or Girl Power.

After the bursary application deadline, applicants will be contacted by phone or lettermail about their bursary.
